Entry blanks must be signed by owner, agent. Exhibitor, or trainer We would request that you please get your entries into the show secretary as QUICKLY as possible to facilitate accuracy and to avoid the rush of morning entries. You can fax, e-mail, or US mail them to arrive by **June 7th.**

Please make sure you do not use stalls that you did not reserve for any reason as the show is responsible for paying for any stall with items or animals placed in them.

All camping reservations and shavings orders are to be placed with the show secretary and will be added to your entry blank. Stalls will be assigned by the show management on a first paid, first served basis.

MINNESOTA HEALTH REQUIREMENTS All horses on the grounds must be in good health. Animals showing evidence of contagious or infectious diseases will be removed from the grounds by order of the official veterinarian. Horses originating from outside Minnesota must be accompanied by an Interstate Health Certificate issued by a licensed veterinarian within thirty (30) days prior to the exhibition identifying each horse and certifying that it is free, insofar as can be determined, from infectious disease. A negative Coggins test for Equine Infectious Anemia within six (12) months and proof of Equine Influenza Virus and Equine Herpes Virus (Rhinopneumonitis) vaccination within (6) months of entering the stable or fairgrounds must accompany each horse. These documents must be recorded by the office personnel for each horse brought onto the fairgrounds. All horses must have a current 2022 negative Coggins test.

Academy and Schooling Classes \$20 Stakes \$25

Regular Classes \$25 Stakes \$35

Tabs may be run by leaving a signed check in the office at the start of the show. Please settle your accounts early on Sunday. All checks payable to MN Horse Show Services

Academy classes to be split into to A, B or C splits as needed.

A = 10 + shows

B = 6 - 10 shows

C = 5 or less shows

Note: If two riders in any split are sharing a horse, the less experienced to move down a split.

No qualification is required for stakes, but if a horse is shown in a qualifier, it must show in that stake if you show back. All qualifying classes will receive trophies and ribbons.

Training classes will be show attire optional, but neat and tidy attire is suggested.

For pleasure classes, if the class size is 5 or more we may spit by age group but run the classes concurrently.

Equitation stake classes will include a pattern


